NCIDQ PROFESSIONAL Practicum

- Review is provided for Practicum Part A, B and C on two evening sessions. Participants will solve a practice design Practicum in the similar time format as Exam Day; Part A, (Space Planning and Lighting) in one session, and Parts B and C, (Egress, Life Safety, Restroom, Systems Integration and Millwork) in the other session.

NCIDQ IDFX or IDPX Preparation

- A general overview of test material for the NCIDQ IDFX and IDPX exams will be presented in two separate sessions. The exam content will be discussed, along with what to expect on exam day. A review of all NCIDQ preparation materials is provided. The Monday (2/8) session will cover IDFX preparation and is recommended for recent graduates as well as professionals who have to write this section. The Wednesday (2/10) session covers IDPX preparation and is recommended for professionals only.
