







## Project Statement: Gemutlichkeit (Translation: Comfort)

Riverworks meets the traditional Biergarten, a Bavarian invention developed in the mid-19<sup>th</sup> century that has become a fixture of German beer culture throughout the entire country. A Biergarten, by definition, is an outdoor area in which beer and local food are served. According to German standards, the most important characteristic of a Biergarten is that it promotes a feeling of warmth, friendliness, and belonging. The design for the Restaurant focuses of the authenticity, craft and heritage of the Biergarten. Traditional elements are given an updated look paired with a blend of textural woods, fabrics, and metal frame work resulting in a warm, urban space. A neutral palette accented with rich, vibrant blues adds a calm and comfortable feel while emulating the colors of the Bavarian flag.



Large pass-through windows with sculptural steel framing link the kitchen to the Dining Hall, giving customers a view into the kitchen while still providing separation and privacy.








Further into the space is the **Bar**. Here the ceiling is lowered to 10', creating a more intimate seating alternative.
