Sample Outline of a Constitution

The following outline is designed to help you write a constitution for your club/organization. The constitution should contain statements concerning enduring aspects of the organization. Items that are subject to frequent revision should be included in the by-laws.

ARTICLE I - Name, Purpose, and Affiliation

Section 3 Organization affiliations (local, state, national, etc.)

ARTICLE II - Membership

Section 1 Membership requirements (listed as "a," "b," "c," etc.)

Section 3 Statement indicating the organization does not discriminate on the basis of age,

race, religion, creed, color, sec. national ort ethnic origin, marital status, or physical

or mental disability

ARTICLE III - Officers

Section 1 List of officers (president, secretary, etc.)

Section 2 Qualifications of officers

Section 3 Duties of officers: clearly defined roles and responsibilities

ARTICLE IV - Advisor

Section 1 How the advisor is chosen Section 2 Qualifications of advisor

Section 3 Duties and responsibilities of advisor

ARTICLE V - Election and Removal of Officers
