POSITION SUMMARY:

The BFA in Game Design Program at Villa Maria College began fall 2019 and is a competitive, hands-on, and demanding program that recruits highly-talented and committed students. At Villa, the 9:1 student to faculty ratio enables instructors to have a meaningful impact on the artistic development of each and every student. Villa Maria has four state-of-the-art computer labs, each with 14-20 workstations with Cintiq tablets. The labs are equipped with Industry Standard software, such as; the Adobe Creative Suite, Autodesk Maya, Toon Boom Harmony and Storyboard Pro, and both the Unity and Unreal Game Engines. Cross-program collaboration is also strongly encouraged. Every program at Villa offers a Minor, and the BFA in Game Design and Development intentionally has five General Electives in the planner to allow our students to easily take a minor and better focus on their interests in the field.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- M.F.A. in Game Design/Development is highly preferred; however alternative degrees will be considered.
- Knowledge of Software Prototyping and/or Game Development using either the Unreal Game Engine or Unity Game Engine required.
- Knowledge of 3D animation software preferred.
- Production Management experience preferred.
- Game Design or Animation Industry experience preferred.
- Teaching experience preferred.

ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Teach a minimum of 24 credit hour equivalences per year.
- Provide student-centered instruction in all courses.
- Provide direction and climate for effective learning.

- Design means of evaluating and improving the teaching/learning process in the classroom
- Pursue professional development and growth.
- Review and develop curricula.
- Serves as academic advisor to students
- Participate in program assessment activities.
- Participate in program and College accreditation activities.
- Submit required reports to appropriate offices
- Attend schedule program meetings and maintain regular office hours.
- Develop plans for the use of equipment, instructional aids, and supplies.
- Assist in the development of grant materials relevant to the faculty member's role and duties at the College.
